

# Cutting the cost of report distribution at Roehampton University

### Easy information access

The changing nature of education around the world is adding increasing demands on the modern education establishment like Roehampton University. To deliver the best education to students, universities and colleges now link to other institutions anywhere in the world. This makes it essential to create easy access to information for faculties and staff, at anytime and anywhere. However, Roehampton faced increasing costs for distributing reports to staff using its existing reporting solution.

As a result, the University has now implemented the Ariel Alert reporting and alerting solution from Ariel Corporation to cost-effectively distribute and provide access to its existing reporting software and vital administrative information. This reduces the need for time-intensive management and maintenance, and takes the strain off the University's internal IT resources."

### Threshold alerting

Ariel Alert is a low-cost solution that integrates with major business intelligence and reporting solutions to automate the distribution and scheduling of reports and information snapshots. This information can be made available in a number of formats, including Word, Excel, HTML, XML and PDF documents, and can be viewed and distributed via standard Web browsers, email, SMS text or direct to users' desktops.

The solution can also be used to set up specific event and threshold system alerts to notify users of critical business developments the moment they arise. Roehampton University is considering using this innovative function to enable users to define, request and receive customised alerts when specific reports become available, to further improve the ease in which critical information is accessed and analysed across its organisation.
